NOTIFICATION

Government of Andhra Pradesh has undertaken development of a Metro Rail system in Hyderabad for a length of 71.16 km covering 3 corridors viz., Corridor-I (Miyapur to LB Nagar – 28.87 km); Corridor-II (JBS to Falaknuma – 14.78 km); and Corridor-III (Nagole to Shilparamam – 27.51 km). The depot for Corridor-III was indicated as 'Nagole Depot' in the Detailed Project Report (DPR) prepared by the Delhi Metro Rail Corporation and accordingly it was mentioned as 'Depot-III (Nagole)' in the Concession Agreement. Various representations have been made to the Government subsequently that the proposed depot at Corridor-III is actually located in Uppal Bhagath village, with a request to call it Uppal Depot. After due consideration, the Government has agreed to this request. Accordingly, it is hereby notified that 'Depot-III (Nagole)' shall hereinafter be called 'Depot-III (Uppal)'.
