

# 'Metro Rail will transform city'

Claiming that Hyderabad Metro Rail project would have a cutting edge signaling control and train system (CBTC - Communication Based Train Control) for the first time in the country, HMR managing director N V S Reddy hailed the project would revolutionise the city.

Speaking at a conference held at the Federation of Andhra Pradesh Chambers of Commerce and Industry (FAPCCI), he said that HMR was a trend setting project that would ensure change not only in the city, but also in the country.

He said that HMR was utilising several state-of-the-art technologies that were not implemented anywhere in the country. He said that stations would be constructed with the help of cantilever technology that ensured pillars only in the middle and assured that stations would be eco-friendly, mostly using natural light and ventilation.
