

## 'HMR School to be Better than Best'

**Hyderabad:** The government high school complex which is being built at Chaderghat will be one of the best school complexes in the twin cities and will be better than even corporate school buildings, in terms of infrastructure, facilities and amenities Hyderabad Metro Rail (HMR), Managing Director NVS Reddy has declared.

The school complex is being built in 40,000 sq.ft with an estimated cost of ₹5.5 crore. He also said that the school is being built as per the HMR standards and is being built similar to the government high school constructed by Hyderabad Metro Rail at Kukatpally last year.

NVS Reddy inspected the ongoing construction works of the school being built by Hyderabad Metro Rail at Chaderghat on Thursday.

Later speaking to media persons, he said that the school complex will have four floors with both English and Telugu medium classes. It is being constructed in a much larger area with better facilities and amenities and will serve as an alternative to four existing individual government schools in Chaderghat area which were affected by Metro Rail alignment.

The new school complex will be ready in the next few weeks, he said.
